

**PERRY COUNTY  
LOCAL EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION**

Perry County, Indiana  
Date: 02-15-2021

**AUTHORITY**

Whereas, Perry County, Indiana has been or is immediately threatened by a natural/man-made/technological hazard and/or nuclear or conventional attack, and;

**02-15-2021 1500- Perry County Indiana has encountered a snow/ice emergency. This snow/ice emergency is beyond the capabilities of the local County resources.**

Due to the amount of snow and ice on roadways, Perry County is unable to keep the roadways clear for safe travel.

Thus, as a protection to the citizens of Perry County, we, the Perry County Board of Commissioners are **“encouraging” all citizens to be alert of the road conditions and refrain from travel on the snow covered roadways unless absolutely necessary.** This Emergency Proclamation does **NOT** close any roads in Perry County. This Emergency Proclamation will remain effective until canceled.

Now, therefore, we, the Perry County Board of Commissioners, declare that a local disaster emergency exists in the county and that we hereby invoke and declare those portions of the Indiana Code which are applicable to the conditions and have caused the issuance of this proclamation, to be in full force and effect in the county for the exercise of all necessary emergency authority for protection of the lives and property of the people of Perry County and the restoration of local government with a minimum of interruption.

Reference is hereby made to all appropriate laws, statutes, ordinances and resolutions, and particularly to Section 10-14-3-29 of the Indiana Code.

All public offices and employees of Perry County are hereby directed to exercise the utmost diligence in the discharge of duties required of them for the duration of the emergency and in execution of emergency laws, regulations, and directives—state and local.

All citizens are called upon and directed to comply with necessary emergency measures, to cooperate with public officials and disaster services forces in executing emergency operations plans, and to obey and comply with the lawful directions of properly identified officers.

All operating forces will direct their communications and requests for assistance and operations directly to the Emergency Operating Center.
